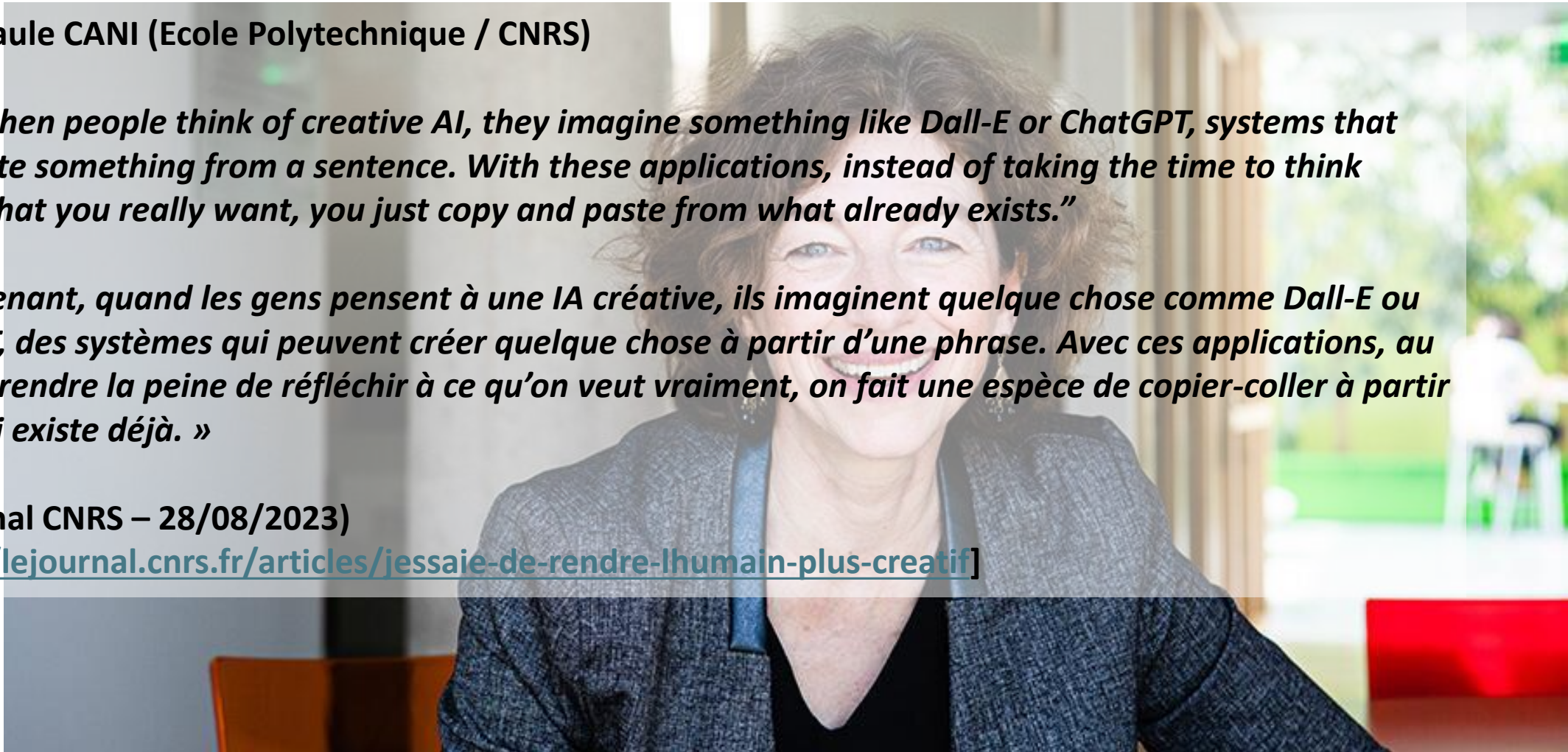

28 th October – 11 th November 2024 @2PM	Students' free choice of supervisors on the online database on WebRISE (from this point, students can start working on BD and discuss with his/her supervisor)
12 th -15 th November 2024	Allocation of supervisors to students who have made a choice on the WebRISE (done by administration)
Mid-November 2024 to May 2025	Independent work on Bachelor Dissertation, with the support of the supervisor
5 th December 2024 @2PM	Milestone 1. Topic Form Electronic version to be submitted on Moodle. 5% of final grade <i>Supervisor feedback before Christmas Holidays or during first half of January (email and/or meeting)</i>
27 th February 2025 @2PM	Milestone 2. Intermediate Report Electronic version to be submitted on Moodle. Assessment here ↓
3 rd -17 th March 2025	Milestone 2. Mandatory assessed Meeting A mandatory meeting is organized between student and supervisor (15min), live or remote. 15% of final grade

→ *A first document to discuss with your Supervisor*

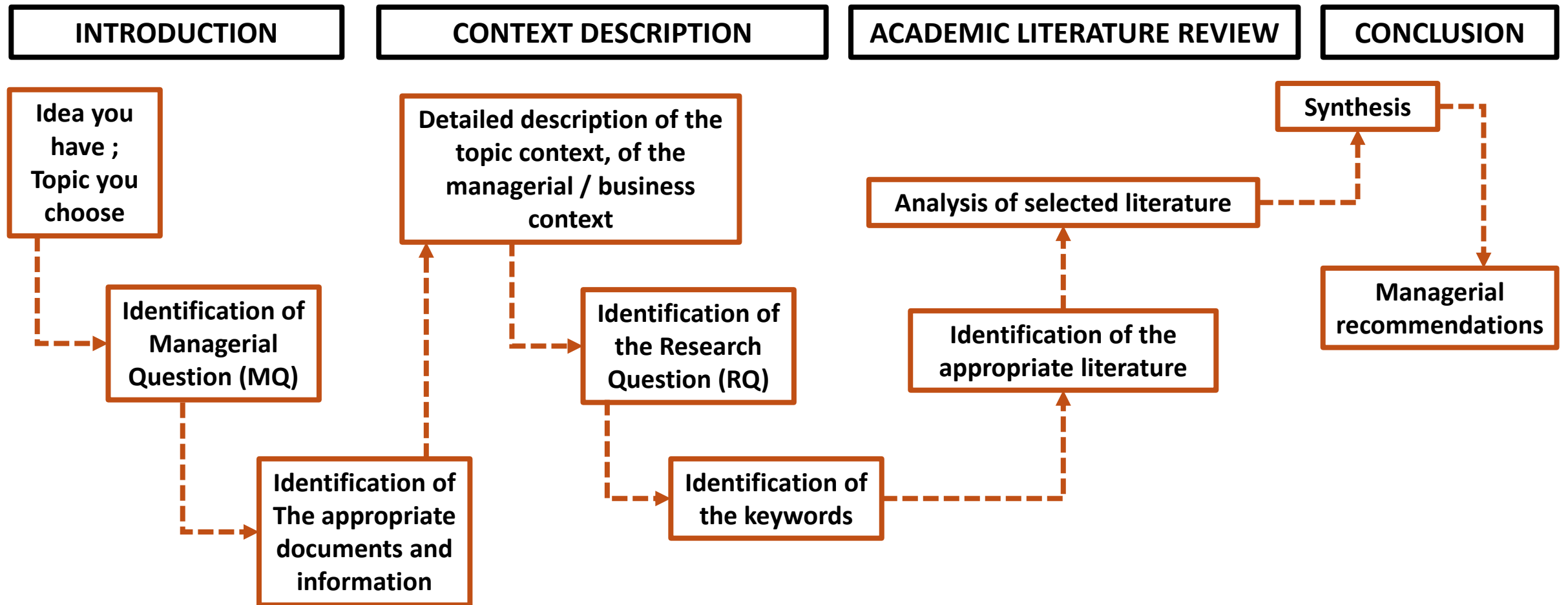

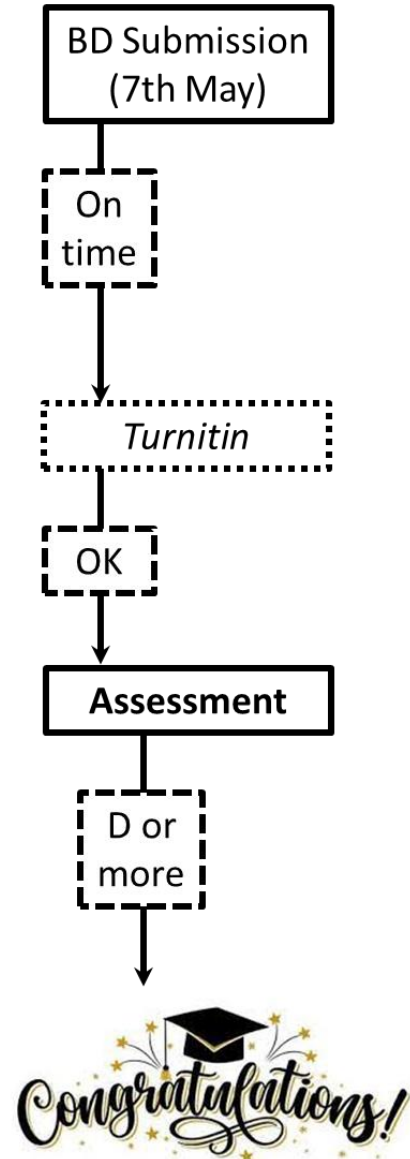

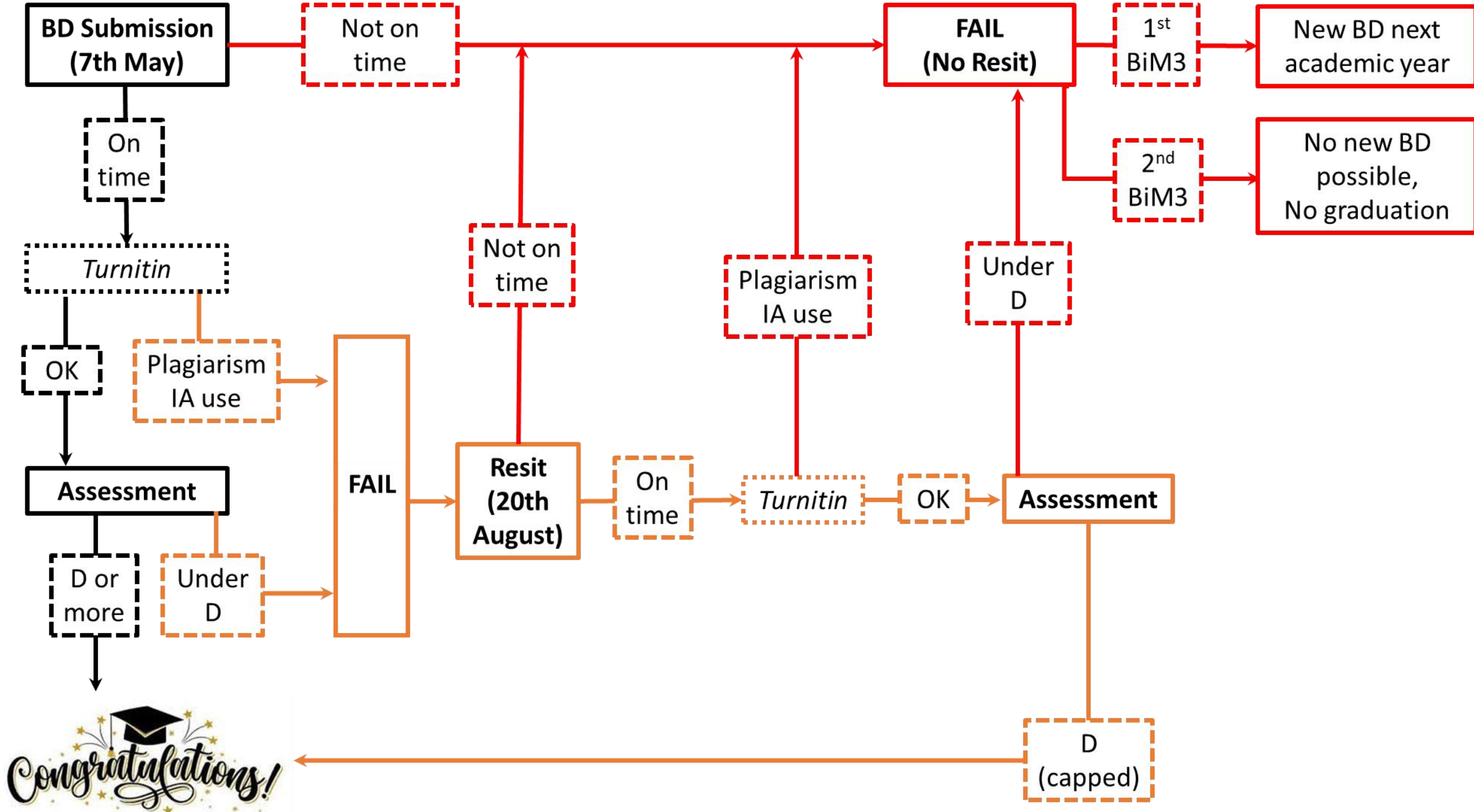
