

Case 2 : You obtained after any resit an annual GPA≥2 but you have still one or more F

- => Repeat part of the BiM3 programme and
- => No graduation possible
- => postpone plans

Case 3: You have validated all your courses, but your GPA is between 1,7 and 2

- => Total or partial repetition of BiM3 and
- => No graduation possible
- => postpone plans
