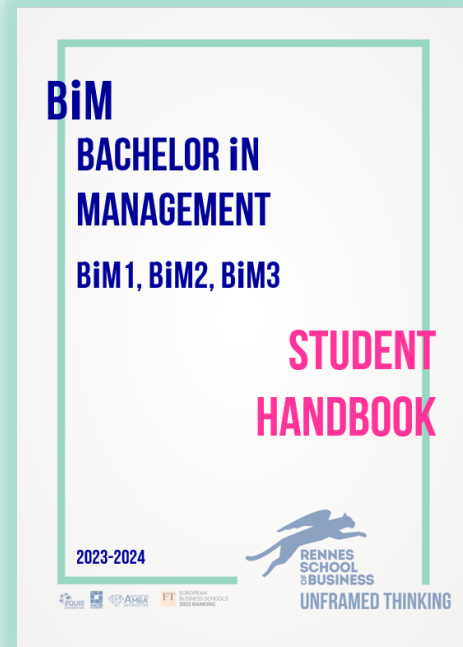

# BEFORE WE GET INTO DETAILS



Do not send your request several times:  
**one** email or **one** visit is sufficient 😊

This is an **ACADEMIC** exchange > **STUDY** 😊

**Get yourself prepared** with local teaching methods

**Check the local academic expectations** to ensure that you know how to learn

## In case you fail

- Some universities organize resit sessions > take this chance!
- If not: you will have to register on additional classes in Rennes during the following year (tuition fees involved).

# FOR YOUR APPLICATION



Every university has a different application process:  
You will be **guided** by your Exchange Coordinator but you remain **the main actor** of the process!



Respect the **deadlines!** Delay = refusal from the university!



If a **language certificate** is needed = delivered by your coordinator in Rennes (you don't need to rely on your language professors)



**Information from the partner universities is provided at their convenience:** we will contact you as soon as we have news to forward you. Do not worry if your friends already have information 😊

Same rule applies for the scholarships (Erasmus+) > we will contact you directly

# GET YOUR STAY PREPARED



## Travel tickets

Wait until you receive your acceptance letter



**Visa** > to be organised on your own  
Check the requested documents and delays.

**BE CAREFUL: A visa is necessary for non-EU students studying in Europe.**



**Insurance (health + travel)** > to be purchased in France before departure unless communicated otherwise by host university (ie : USA/Australia...)



**Accommodation** > to be organized on your own.

Check information provided by partner university or student associations

**ASAP!**

# BEFORE YOUR ARRIVAL

- 28 ECTS credits for S5 or 24 ECTS credits for S6
- Consider the credit equivalence when not ECTS (outside of Europe)
- Business courses only linked to your professional projects
- Language courses or courses in French cannot be transferred
- Choose at least one additional course
- Validate your Learning Agreement by RSB + your host university
- To return to your Exchange Coordinator within 15 days upon arrival

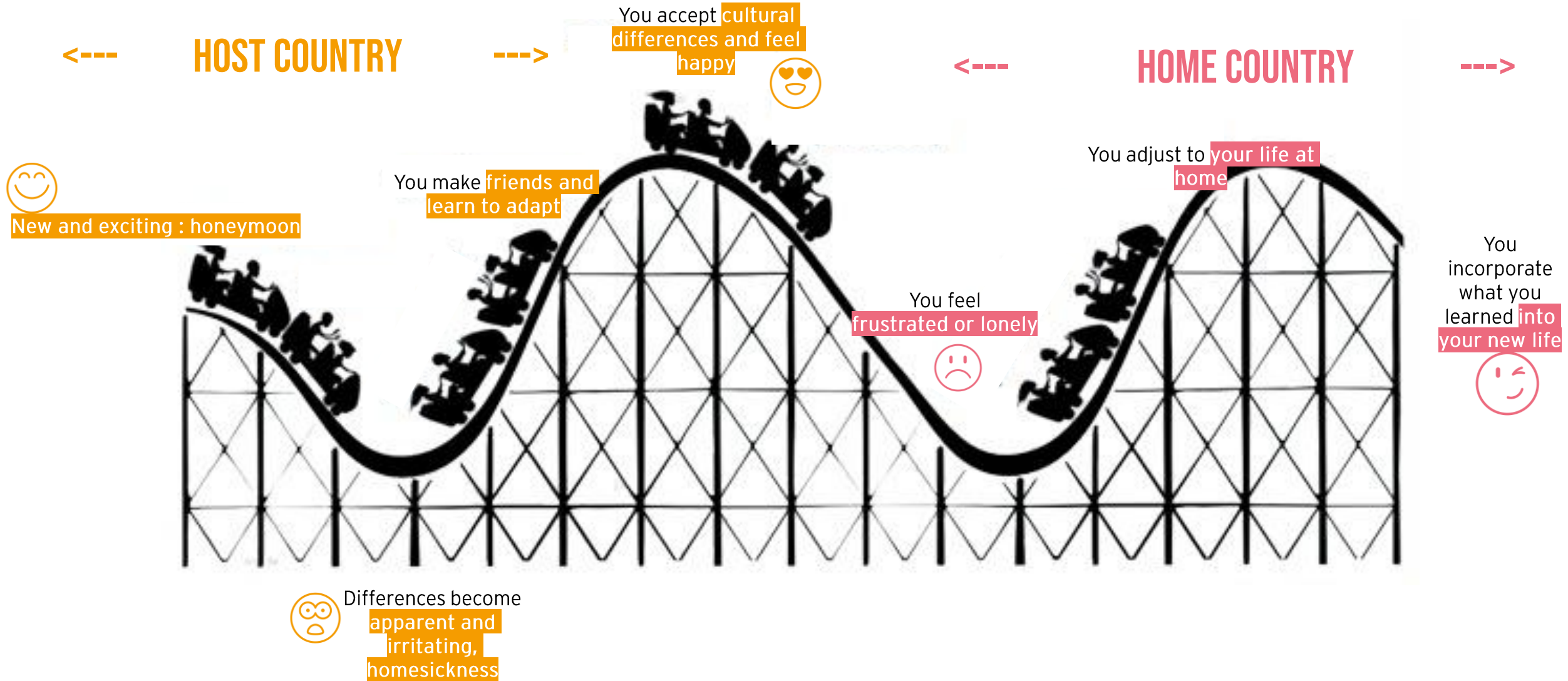

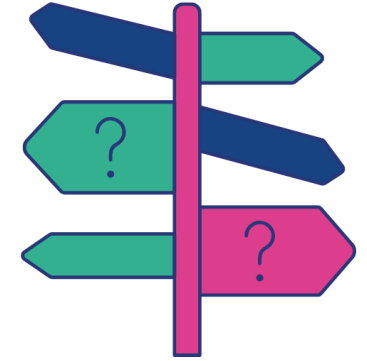
